The Tractor Sales

The building is a Thomas Yorke Bank/Jail kit and the trees are made from Woodland Scenics products. The man with the club and the boy are from The Aspen Modeling Company and the salesman is from Builders In Scale. The tractor is one of the Athearn 1/50 scale diecast models.



Early Morning Delivery

Female figures painted by Granite Creek Enterprises. The delivery man is from OnTrak Model Products. Vehicle is a Berskshire Valley kit and crates are from Hamm River Model Products



New Office Space

The old T.M. Hedison Carriage Co. building has finally been sold and remodeled. Two small office spaces have been leased. The building is made with Design Preservation Models O scale modular walls. Scenery is from Woodland Scenics.



Repairs in the Courtyard

The carpenter is from The Aspen Modeling Company. The benches, trash cans, and the brick pedestals (the tops of chimneys) are Builders In Scale. The monument is from Schomberg Scale Models. The flower pots (fruit/vegetable baskets) are from Hamm River Model Products.



Everett County Fire Department

Buildings are from Railway Design Associates, the flatcar is an Evergreen Hill Designs kit. The dock is made up of a kitbashed Wolf Designs HO kit on the left and an O scale Schomberg Scale Models on the right. Firetruck is a Matchbox Models of Yesteryear diecast vehicle. Track is Bachman E-Z Track.



Tension at Tumbleweed

The Thomas A. Yorke saloon and The Paper Creek Model Works Randsburg Barbershop make a great backdrop for these old west figures from The Honourable Lead Boiler Suit Company and The Paper Street Soap Company. The wagon wheels are from an old 20 MuleTeam kit. Tumbleweeds made from Woodland Scenics materials.



Bandits in the Trash

The critters are having an all out assault on the contents of these trash cans. Raccoon/trash cans by OnTrak Products, building is from RDA and grass is made from Woodland scenics materials.



At the Public Dock

The baggage car is from Railway Design Associates and has Alan Curtiss trucks with Northwest Shortline Wheelsets. The engine is a Bachmann HO scale 0-6-0 with a Backwoods Miniatures Select-A-Kit O scale conversion body.



The Sawmill

The logging train crew is taking a break after unloading the logs. The saw mill building is kitbashed from a Walther's Sur-Sweet Feeds kit.



Disconnects

These disconnects are from Granite Creek Enterprises and are sitting on Bachmann E-Z Track. The boiler on the dock is a Granite Creek Enterprises casting.



Lumberjacks by the Tracks

The loggers are a set from Fun & Games. The caboose is a Cache Creek Models kit and the skeleton log car and trucks are Alan Curtiss kits. Wheelsets are Jay Bee Enterprises HO scale 40" diameter. Both have Kadee HO scale couplers. Ground cover made from Woodland Scenics materials.

Conversation

Fireman and Engineer from Lee town Models, painted by Granite Creek Enterprises. Man with oil can is from The Aspen Modeling Company. Chains and tarpaper roofing on the Shay are from Builders In Scale. The shay is a Bachmann On30 Two Truck shay with a Banta Model Works long cab kit. Couplers are Kadee On3 couplers.





Water Stop

Tankcar is a Rio Grande Hobbies kit and the engine is a Bachmann On30 Porter. Behind on the right is a Bachmann passenger car converted to an office. On the left is an Atlas O scale reefer converted to a storage shed. Water tank is scratchbuilt. Track is Bachmann E-Z track and ground cover from Woodland Scenics.



Engine House

Stone Mill Models engine house kit with a Miniatures by Eric (MBE) flatcar sitting in the doorway. In the background a MBE open side passenger car is being restored. Details on the flatcar are from Hamm River.



Retirement

This Atlas O scale reefer body has been converted to a storage shed using a Builders In Scale door; windows and the fence in the back on the right are from a Walthers structure kit, and the sliding door is scratchbuilt from Evergreen Scale Models styrene. The crates and drums are from Hamm River and the pipes made from K&S brass tubing. The shed on the left and the logging disconnects on the far right were built by Rick Perry.
